- Pocket Folders with 3 prong center fasteners

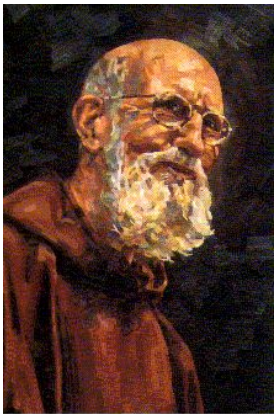
